Hotel Accommodations

The Scottsdale Plaza Resort, located in North Scottsdale, will be the host hotel for our 24th Annual Conference. It is located at 7200 N. Scottsdale Road, Scottsdale, AZ 85253. Room rates are \$145.00 per night (plus taxes) single & double occupancy. Bellman gratuities of \$4.00 per person, each way and maid gratuity of \$2.00 per room night will be posted to the individual's room folio. **In order to receive this discounted rate, reservations must be made with the hotel by August 14, 2009 and you must tell them you are with the NALTA Conference when making your reservation.** Please advise at the time the reservation is made if you require any auxiliary aides. After August 14, 2009, rooms will be confirmed by the hotel on a space and rate available basis. A major credit card must be used to guarantee the room reservation. **No shows or cancellations less than 5 days prior to check-in will be billed to the credit card for one night's room and tax.** Check-in time is 3:00 p.m. and check-out time is 12:00 noon. The Scottsdale Plaza Resort Airport Shuttle is \$20.00 inclusive of tax and gratuity one way per person. It is recommended that you advise the Hotel of your anticipated arrival time in order to ensure that shuttles may be more promptly available.

Airline Travel

American Airlines offers a discount of 5% valid for travel dates 09-11-09 through 09-20-09. Travelers must book on line at www.aa.com and must input the authorization number **A3799AE** as the promotion code at the time of booking. Reservations can also be made by phone at 800-433-1790 (a \$20 fee per ticket applies). **Continental Airlines** offers discounts off published fares of 2% to 15%. Ground Transportation *** Airport Shuttle Service

Upon arriving at the airport, use the courtesy phone to arrange for shuttle service transportation to The Scottsdale Plaza. A courtesy phone is located at the baggage claim area in each of the airport terminals. Dial 40, which is the number labeled "The Scottsdale Plaza Resort". If you are unable to locate the courtesy phone, please call 480-951-5118 for direct connection. Guests should retrieve their luggage prior to calling for shuttle service. Guests will be asked their name, the airline they arrived on, and the number in their party. Guests are directed to the north curb "Resort Shuttles Vehicle Loading" area (distinguished by a sign with a blue diamond). The

shuttle departs the airport every half-hour from 5:30 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. There is a charge of \$20 per person each way. This price includes the driver gratuity, which is posted directly to the individual's room account. Taxi cab rates from airport to the hotel are approximately \$36-39.00 each way.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations received in writing addressed to the Conference Registration Chairman, Joyce Snell by August 14, 2009 are fully refundable. **No refunds will be given for cancellations made after August 14, 2009.** Substitutions are allowed according to the guidelines in the confirmation package. Individuals are responsible for canceling their own hotel reservations.
