Dear NALTA Member(s):

As we celebrate our 25th Anniversary, it is my pleasure to begin our 2010 Membership Drive with the introduction of our new ONLINE Membership Registration. For the first time, new and existing NALTA members will be able to register for membership with NALTA online through our website www.nalta.org. Membership will now have easy access to timely information, online renewal of membership and change of address updates, electronic on-line member directory and much more. Additionally, the Board and committees will now have a place to electronically collaborate work efforts as well as a CPLTA forum that is in the works.

Attached you will find an easy to follow and well illustrated tutorial on how to set up your password and complete the renewal process. We have also provided answers to those frequently asked questions, but should you have others, please feel free to contact our Membership Chairman, Linda Howerton or myself and we will be happy to assist you.

This year has brought about some changes in the renewal process of which you need to be aware:

- 1) The dual registration you have enjoyed in the past (Local Chapter and NALTA Membership) has been discontinued. You must join each organization separately, and provide separate checks to each. With 1800+ members it was time for NALTA to automate their services to better serve you, the members, and provide our volunteers with some badly needed assistance, in order to accomplish this, the change was necessary.
- 2) When you join NALTA online you do not need to complete a paper application. After completing the registration process you will receive an email Invoice that must be printed and accompany your check for the \$50.00 renewal fee. Once your payment has been processed you will receive an email stating your membership completed successfully.
- 3) Due to the separate registrations, there will no longer be a \$5.00 discount available if you continue to join both the local chapters and NALTA. Unlike other organizations, discontinuing the \$5.00 discount will enable NALTA to maintain the membership fees at the current rate avoiding an increase for the time being.
- 4) NALTA has a new address, and we would ask that you make note of it when you mail your Invoice and check:
